

INSIDE F.U.E.L. & CALIFORNIA STATE PRISON'S PROGRESSIVE PROGRAMING FACILITY (A-YARD)

Inside F.U.E.L. (Families united to end life without the possibility of parole) is an advocacy/support group of men serving life without parole, life with parole, and other long term sentences. Our mission is to promote, encourage, and assist one another in our pursuit of rehabilitation, holding each other accountable, and working together to become people capable of doing something to lift and rebuild the communities we once destroyed. We hold quarterly town halls and facilitate/participate in over 20 peer led self-help groups of which I will present in greater detail bellow. We also host fundraisers for charities as well as community tragedies such as the devastating fires that recently raged through Los Angeles County, specifically Pacific Palisades and Altadena. Upon learning of the fires Inside F.U.E.L in a quick turnaround raised and donated over \$500.

Inside F.U.E.L is not alone in our rehabilitative work. We participate in, support, and are supported by several other organizations and groups on Lancaster Progressive Programing Facility, all of which I will briefly introduce herein.

1. Paws for Life K9 Rescue which consists of 115 participants who train, feed, bathe, and care for dogs that have often been abandoned and/or abused i.e. traumatized in ways that many of the men can relate to and empathize with.
2. Peer-to-Peer mentor self-help programing (Words Uncaged, Lancaster's Accountability Workshop, American Sign Language, Insight Project, Criminal and Addictive Thinking, Community Building/Self –Help mentoring Program, Alternative To Violence, Preparations For Returning to Society/Peer Development, Victim's Awareness and Survivors Sensitivity, L.W.O.P. Alliance, Financial Literacy, Practical Interviewing Skills (Board PREP), Health & Yoga, Hustle 2.0, Leave The Keys D.U.I. awareness, Breaking the Cycle, Getting out By Going In (G.O.G.I.), Crochet Class, Domestic Abuse, Changing Your Past, Criminal Gangs Anonymous, Powerless to Powerful: Cell Phone Addiction and Walk The Yard.)
3. Higher Learning through the Associates programs is Antelope Valley College, Coastline Community College, Lassen College. The country's largest Bachelor's degree program cohort is California State University, Los Angeles (CSULA), and the Master's degree Program California State Dominguez.

4. Peer-Support Specialist: non-clinicians with specific qualities and/or lived experiences who received special training to deliver support services (mental health care, substance abuse assistance, and rehabilitation services fitted for specific needs.) to their fellow incarcerated peers.
5. Youth Offender Program (Y.O.P.) mentors. Incarcerated men trained in motivational interviewing. Their mission is to provide guidance and encouragement for incarcerated youth, advising them on how best to use their time. Through lived experience YOP mentors show incarcerated youth how to navigate their way through the rehabilitation process.
6. Occupational Mentor Certification Program (O.M.C.P.) Peer mentorship Program: Substance Abuse counseling and self-help group facilitation.
7. The Church of Emanuel: Active participation in human transformation by teaching, preaching, and discipleship through peer led ministries such as Empowered Inside, Malachi Dad's (Parenting and Domestic awareness from a Biblical standpoint), Denial Management, and various Bible study groups. The Church also conducts an evangelism ministry whereupon members visit housing units in rotation twice a month distributing snacks and sodas while sharing the word of God (all comers no distinctions).

The incarcerated population on California State Prison's Progressive Programming Facility (A-Yard) as a collective are in support of Senate Bill 672 for a number of reasons, which include but are not limited to, it extends the consideration of youth factors to a population who has been denied consideration based solely on the fact their charge included a special circumstance, it provides incarcerated individuals who according to science had brains that were not fully developed at the time they committed or was arrested for their life crime, it provides incarcerated individuals an opportunity to demonstrate that they are not incorrigible, and opens the potential opportunity for men who are sincerely regretful and ashamed of their actions to widen the parameters of the amends they are committed to making to their victims, their victim's families, survivors, the community, and society at large.
